### Joshua 3 and 4

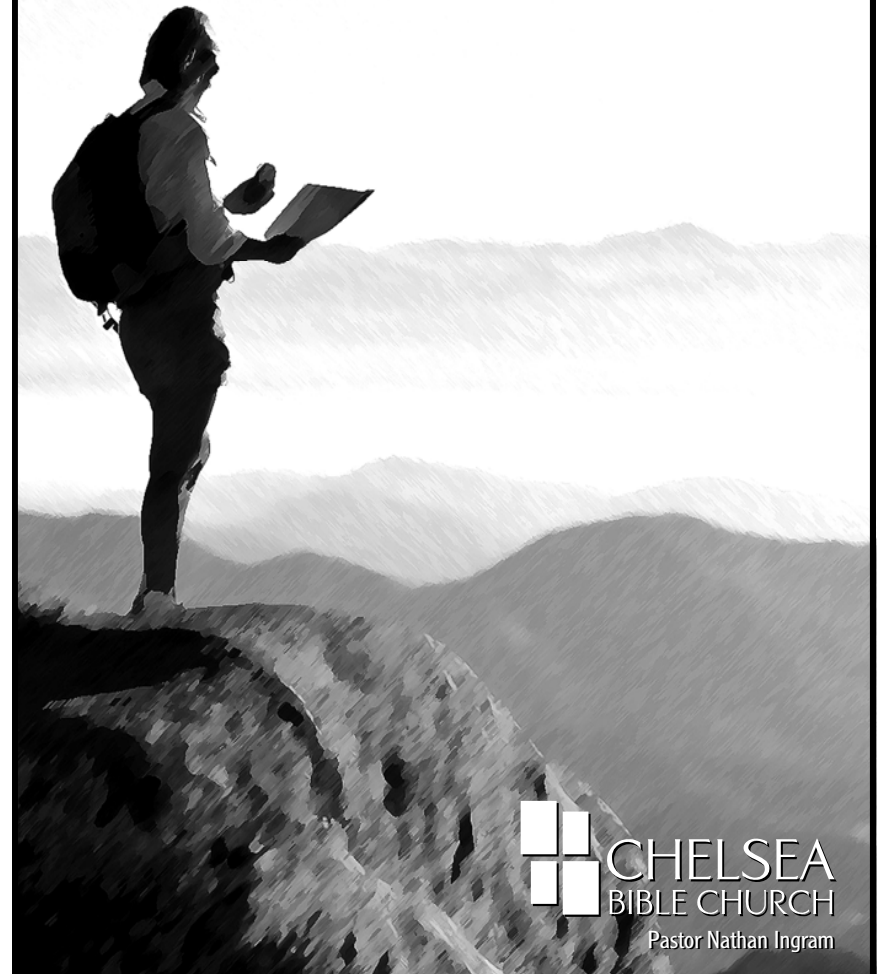
*Use these questions as discussion starters with your family over dinner or during a devotion time... or use them as items for personal reflection in your devotions or journaling.*

1. In Joshua 3:5, the people are called to consecrate themselves. What does this mean? What specific actions did they take? How do we consecrate ourselves today so we are prepared for the work God wants to do in our lives?
2. Put yourself in the position of the people of Israel. Imagine and describe what you would feel as you...
  - ▶ *...Stand on the banks of the Jordan and wonder how you will cross with your family and possessions...*
  - ▶ *...Walk across the dry riverbed...*
  - ▶ *...Stand on the west bank of the Jordan and watch the waters rush back in...*
3. Why do you think God chose the flood season for Israel to cross the Jordan? What does that tell us about how God positions challenges in our lives?
4. What “memorial stones” of God’s past faithfulness can you point to in your own life?
5. What is your impossible river right now? What is God calling you to do about it?

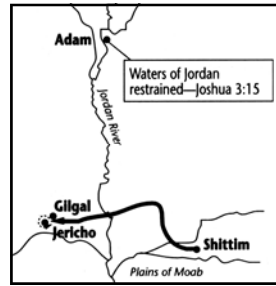
