Joshua 5

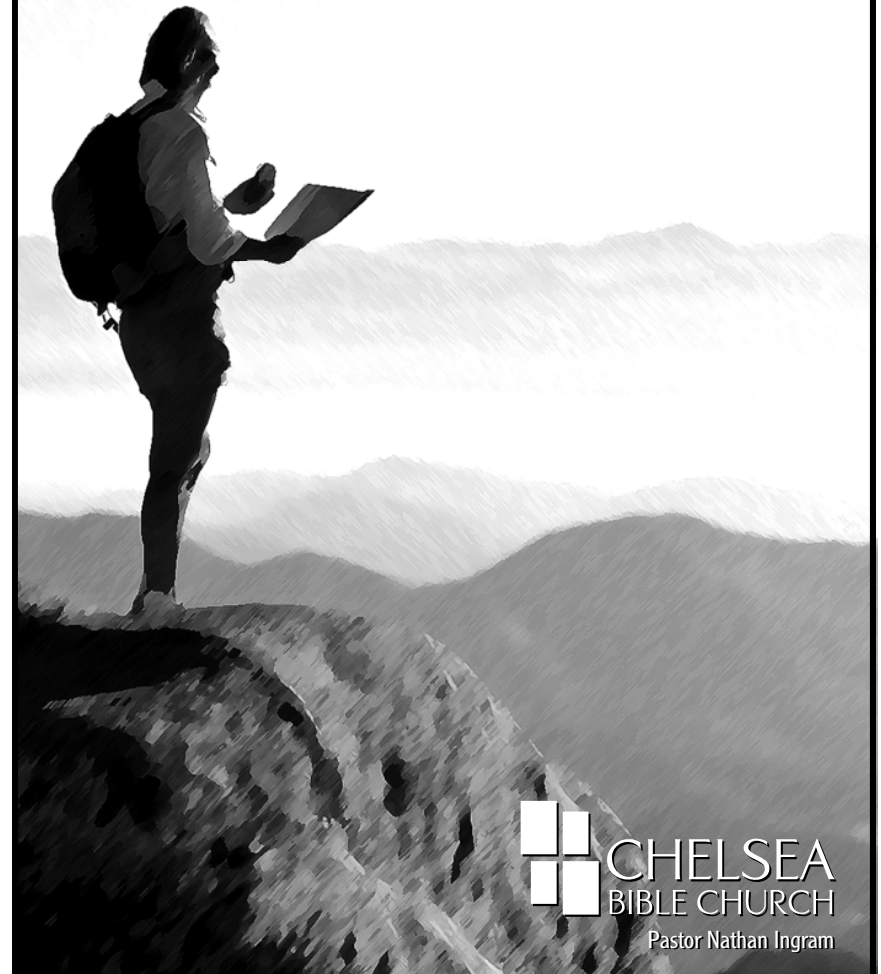
Use these questions as discussion starters with your family over dinner or during a devotion time... or use them as items for personal reflection in your devotions or journaling.

1. Two of the most important ceremonies of Israel are conducted in Joshua 5: circumcision and the Passover. How might these ceremonies prepare Israel for the battles ahead?
2. What memorable events in your past help prepare you for the battles that you or others are facing today?
3. God stopped sending manna the day after Israel feasted on the food of the Promised Land. Why do you think He did this?
4. Has there been a point in your life where God supernaturally sustained you with “manna” in some way? When did it stop? What did you learn from the experience?
5. The Captain of the Hosts reminded Joshua that the battle he was facing was the Lord’s. Take a moment and write out a list of the battles you are facing in your life today. As you honestly search your heart, who is the Commander-in-Chief of these battles—you or the Lord? In what do I need to relinquish control?
6. What question marks exist in my life right now? To which anchor should they be attached?
