But because of who You are

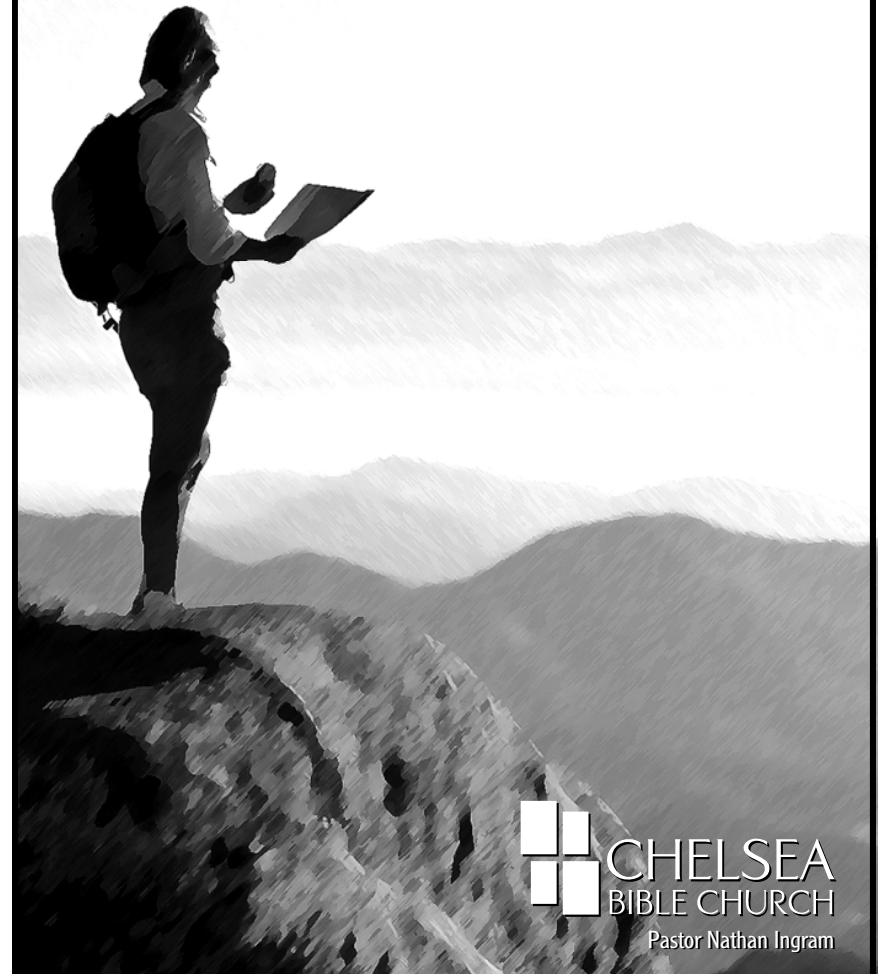
I am a flower quickly fading
