Questions for Personal Reflection

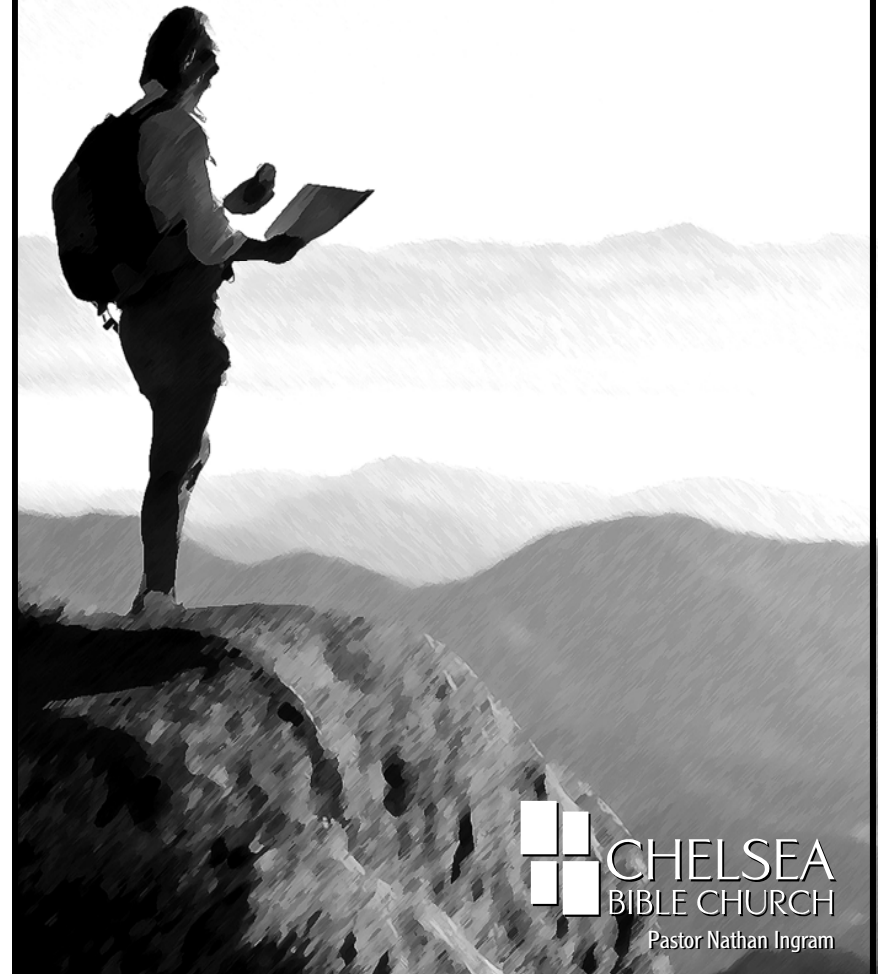
Hebrews 3:12-13
