THE RAPTURE

- Christ comes *for* His own (John 14:3, 1 Thess 14:17, 2 Thess 2:1)
- He comes in the *air* (1 Thess 4:17)
- He *claims* His bride (1 Thess 4:16-17)
- *Only* His own see Him (1 Thess 4:13-18)
- Afterward, the *Tribulation* begins (2 Thess 1:6-9)
- *No signs* precede the Rapture (1 Thess 5:1-3)
- Focus: *The Lord and The Church* (1 Thess 4:13-18)

THE SECOND COMING

- Christ comes *for* His own (1 Thess 3:13, Jude 14, Rev 19:14)
- He comes to the *earth* (Zech 14:4, Acts 1:11)
- He comes *with* His bride (Rev 19:6-14)
- *Every eye* shall see Him (Rev 1:7)
- Afterward, the *Kingdom* begins (Rev 20:1-7)
- *Signs* precede the Second Coming (Lk 21:11,15)
- Focus: *Israel and the Kingdom* (Mt 24:14)

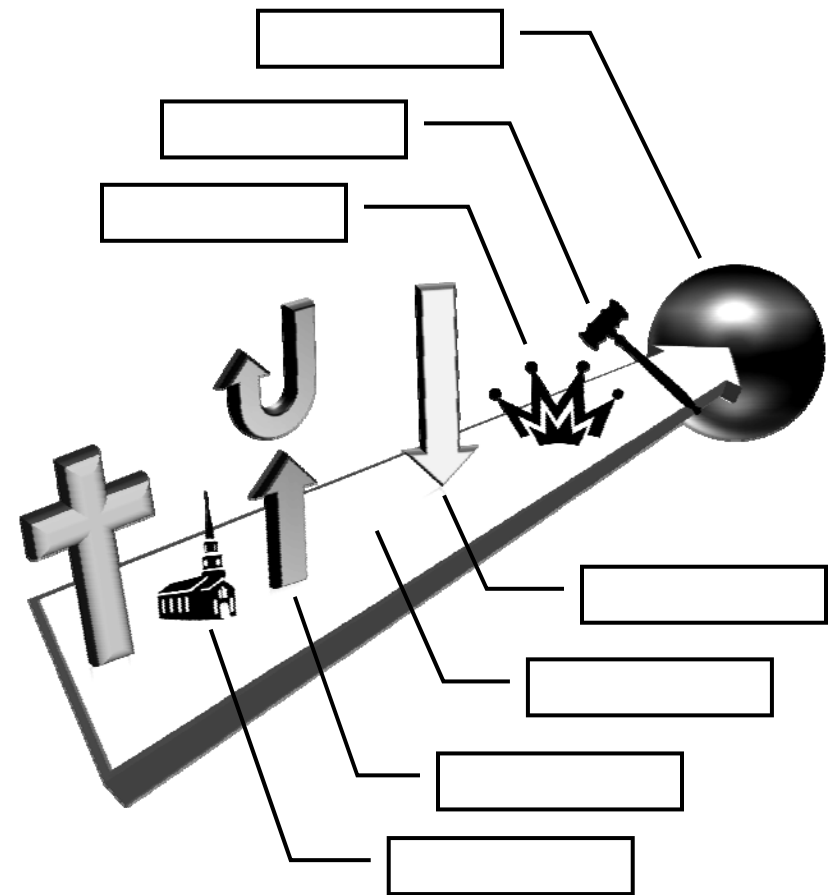

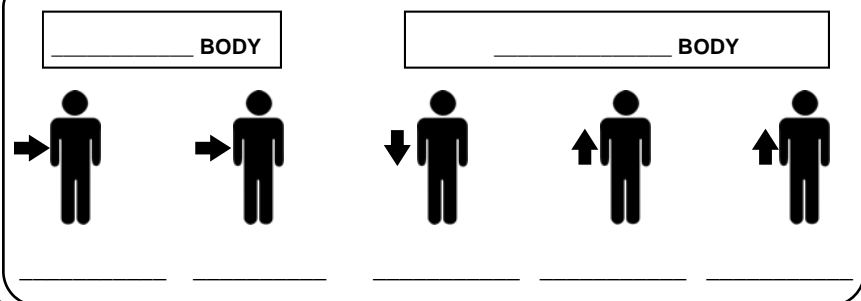
